

1 Q. Have you had any other injury to your neck
2 besides the 1963 incident?

3 A. Yes. On August 21st, 1969, I was working in the
4 Oneida No. 4 Mine in Pennsylvania, and I was coming out of
5 the mine on a jeep. That's a rail vehicle that's on rail
6 with a trolley wire. We were coming out at about 25 mile
7 an hour. I had my head too high, caught my head on a
8 timber, and it hung me by my neck backwards into the track.
9 I did a backwards somersault out of the track -- out of the
10 jeep into the track and broke my neck.

11 Q. Mr. Murray, are you capable of showing the ladies
12 and gentlemen of the jury evidence of your surgeries to
13 your neck?

14 A. Yes.

15 Q. Can you do that?

16 A. Yes, sir.

17 MR. BENNETT: Can you help him, Mr. Jevicky?

18 MR. JEVICKY: Yes.

19 One request we have is we're about to expose it.
20 If anybody was going to take a picture or anything like
21 that -- One person has a camera -- we'd ask that it not be
22 done. We ask that as a courtesy.

23 THE COURT: I would ask that there be no photos
24 taken for this part of the testimony.
